## Ways you can support your child



- Speak with your child about the importance of school and their education



## School Messenger




- The school's primary form of communication is through School Messenger.


To access your child's school's information you will need to get the activation code from the school.



You will need to input your username and password.


This app gives you the ability to save both your username and password.

Once you have inputted your username and password, click "Login"




Once logged in, you will be able to see the information for all of your children.

Click the name of the child you want to review the information.






You can also access messages sent to you from the teacher by clicking on the "Messages" tab at the top of the page.


Once in this tab, click on the message you would like to read.



You can respond to any message from a teacher by clicking on the mail icon in the top right corner of the screen.




To check your child's grades, click on the section that says "Grade Book" with the A+ icon next to it.




Once in this section you will be able to see your child's current grades.
